Sub: For opening a National Institute of Science (NISC) or Indian Institute of Science for Education and Research (IISER) in Bihar.
Ref: Previous letter dated 13 August, 2004 for the same.

Sir,

With due esteem and honour I like to draw your kind attention towards following points

1. Keeping in view role of knowledge and education in transforming India into a developed country, it has been proposed, in the 10th plan of the UGC, to establish National Institutes of Science (NISC) in the different parts of the country.
2. The announcement to set up such institutes was made by our Hon'ble President on December 28, 2003 on the occasion of the concluding ceremony of the Golden Jubilee of the UGC.
3. Accordingly, there has been announcement for establishing National Institute of Science at Allahabad near Allahabad University, at Chennai near Anna University, at Pune near Pune University and at Bhuvaneshwar near Utkal University.(Details can be seen at http://www.ugc.ac.in/new_initiatives/newnis.html).
4. I like to bring it in your kind attention that after the bifurcation of Bihar almost institutes of excellent education and research went into the new born state Jharkhand and thus in the remaining Bihar re-establishment of excellent centre of education and research in science and engineering is urgently needed.
5. On 13-08-2004, I sent an application regarding this to our Hon'ble President and copy of the same was forwarded to the Ministry of HRD, all the MPs from Bihar and then CM of Bihar. Till today, I have not come to receive any information from anywhere in this regard.
6. I also like to bring it in your kind notice that current central government has announced to setup Indian Institute of Science for Education and Research (IISER) at Kolkata, Pune and Chandigarh. It seems that IISER is similar to that of NISc, however, there is no such announcements by the government. But Bihar is again not in the list of states blessed with IISER.

I, therefore, request you to kindly look into the matter so that Bihar, one of the underdeveloped states, can also get an NISC or IISER to explore its capabilities in the area of science education and research.
