Your Excellency,

With due esteem and honor I like to draw your kind attention towards following points

1. Keeping in view role of knowledge and education in transforming India into a developed country, it has been proposed, in the 10th plan of the UGC, to establish National Institutes of Science (NISC) in the different parts of the country.
2. The announcement to set up of such institutes was made by Your Excellency on December 28, 2003 on the occasion of the concluding ceremony of the Golden Jubilee of the UGC.
3. Accordingly, there has been announcement for establishing National Institute of Science at Allahabad near Allahabad University, at Chennai near Anna University, at Pune near Pune University and at Bhubaneswar near Utkal University.(Details can be seen at http://www.ugc.ac.in/new_initiatives/newnis.html).

I like to bring it in your kind attention that after bifurcation of Bihar almost centers of excellent education and research went into the new born state and thus in the remaining Bihar re-establishment of excellent centers of education and research in science and engineering is urgently needed.

5. I do not like to elongate the cause of this request, because Your Excellency situation is better known to you, except requesting you to kindly establish one NISC in Bihar too.

I, therefore, request you to kindly look into the matter so that Bihar, one of the underdeveloped states, can also get a chance to explore its capabilities in the area of science education and research.
